

## Recommendations:

- Use the Filter parameter as much as you can. It will be easier to establish the connection between devices.
- The headset connection by NFC is NOT recommended to use <u>with the NFC scanner connection</u>. It could be problematic during the headset pairing process.

## Notes:

• Vysor app installed at the device may cause the scanner to lose connection

## Configuration:

- 1. Perform Clean boot.
- Scan SPP Bluetooth Classic (Discoverable) barcode\*
- 3. Perform a Cold boot by removing and re-installing the battery onto the RS5100.

\* Use SPP discoverable barcode, when the RS5100 is configured as SPP Master.

## Scanner Type 110:

- The use of ScannerType: 110 for Zebra devices requires the BT Pairing service at Android Accessibility menu option to be activated.
- With the scanner Zebra RS5100, it is convenient to use the Filter parametre (Filter: "RS5100")



to avoid having some problems when you stablish the connection between the device and the scanner.

- In addition, it is convenient to use UnpairAll: true with the Zebra devices.
- Before using the scanner, please, scan the SPP mode:
