Recommendations:

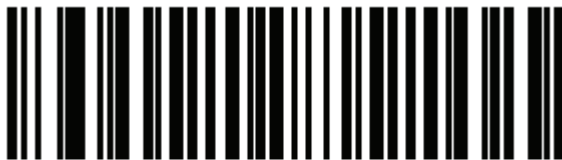
- Use the Filter parameter as much as you can. It will be easier to establish a connection between devices.

Scanner Type 111:

- The use of ScannerType: 111 for Zebra devices requires the BT Pairing service at Android Accessibility menu option to be activated. Also, it is convenient to use UnpairAll: false, to avoid having to scan multiple times to connect the scanner. UnPairAll: true could be more problematic when you establish the connection between the device and the scanner.
- Before using the scanner, please, scan the Non-Discoverable and the AutoReconnect barcodes:
